T-Levels and Apprenticeships

BCE is offering T-Levels, the Level 3 technical qualifications, that come with loads of industry training. They are two year courses equivalent to 3 A-Levels.

T-Levels are designed to feed into apprenticeships and the course content aligns with the relevant apprenticeship standards at Levels 3, 4 and 6.

We will provide a 60 minute workshop for your students, either here or at your school, for your students to discover this new pathway and understand how T-Levels build skills to take into apprenticeships. Our apprenticeships team and former students will talk you through the benefits of these options to secure routes to employment.

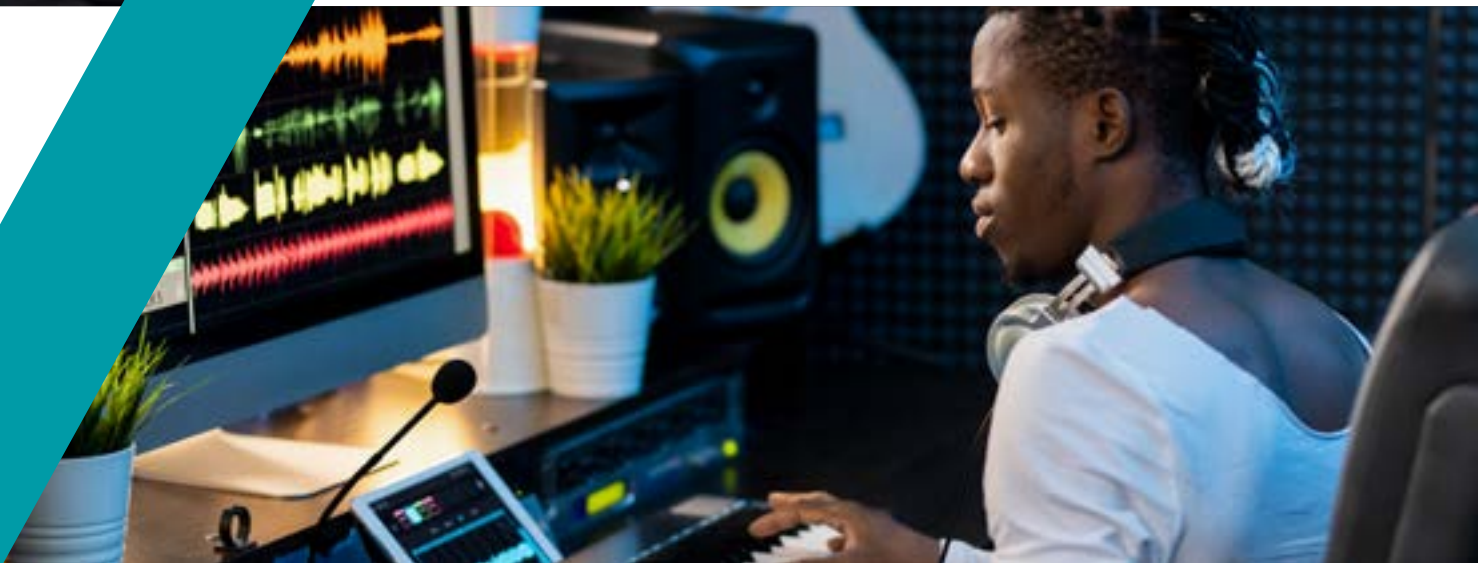


Taster sessions
