## <u>Supported Internships – useful websites for promotion and information</u>

(in alphabetical order, but start with the government or Hampshire site for the best general sources)

Supported internships are structured, work-based study programmes for 16 to 24-year-olds with SEND, who have an education, health and care (EHC) plan. The core aim of a supported internship study programme is a substantial work placement, facilitated by the support of an expert job coach.

Supported interns are enrolled and supported by a learning provider, for example, a school or college, but spend most of their learning time - typically around 70% - in a workplace, gaining the skills they need for work. Alongside their time with the employer, supported interns complete a personalised study programme delivered by the school or college, which includes the chance to study for relevant qualifications, if appropriate.

Supported internships last for a minimum of 6 months, and up to a year.
